





BIGGER & BETTER IN 2016!

The Cherokee Pate Swap Meet has grown to 400 spaces maximum in 2016. If you were a vendor in 2015 you were protected on your existing booth spaces if you paid for them at the end of the 2015 Show or within 30 days following. Due to very good sales, most 2015 vendors also requested expanded space for 2016. As of February 22nd, 265 spaces are gone already. Once the 400 spaces are sold, we cannot guarantee you where you will be placed in the Pate Swap Meet.



A **Vendor Registration Form** is attached on the next page for you to obtain space for the 2016 Show. Please fill it out and follow instructions carefully to ensure spaces. Or call or email Shelby Withrow, Chairman at the information provided on the registration form.

Also attached are a **Pate Swap Meet Maps** and a **Rule Sheet**. Cherokee and Pate Management adhere strictly to all rules due the 10,000 vendors spaces, and the over 120,000 general public whom attend this show. There is **FREE ADMISSION** to the general public so the opportunity for you to sell are far better as compared to many other shows who charge an entry fee to the public and therefore has far smaller attendance at the gate.

Remember... 1) Get your 2016 vendor spots right now! 2) Reserve your existing 2016 spaces for 2017 during the 2016 show. 3) If you want to improve your 2016 spaces for 2017 by adding to them or to get on the top of the list for preferred location choices for 2017, you must pay for next years spaces during the 2016 show or within 30 days following the 2016 show. NO EXCEPTIONS!

Cost to Display your vintage motorcycle(s) is a voluntary minimum one time donation of \$25 for first + \$15 each for the extra motorcycles for 1 to 4 days in the main Cherokee Concourse De Pate display area to help defray the chapters cost of the display area. This is a terrific opportunity to get our Chapter & our machines in front of the tens of thousands who attend.

Vendor spaces for selling motorcycle related items are also available (see box below for details.) Because Pate sells out the entire 9 acres of spots every year, <u>anyone wanting to vend in the motorcycle section needs to contact us ASAP</u> so we can have adequate spaces for the demand. This will be the 2nd annual Cherokee Chapter event that will grow each year as more spots become available to us, **Do not hesitate...reserve your spaces NOW!**










PATE SWAP MEET/CHEROKEE CONCOURS & 'PATE SHOW GROUNDS RULES AT A GLANCE

- ▶ Vendor's Gates open at 7:00 am daily. Public Gates open at 10:00 am daily.
- ▶ The Swap Meet and Concours d'Pate Bike Show are open 10-5 daily.
- If you register in advance a Windshield Parking Sticker will be mailed to you.
- Color Coded Windshield Stickers correlate to your parking area. No in and out privileges.
 - Cars and Trucks \$5 per day
 - RV's \$20 for all 4 days.
- ▶ If your register at the show, you will need to use the outer ring road around the Texas Motor Speedway. A Texas Motor Speedway Staff person will collect the \$5 per day parking fee and give you a Windshield Sticker.
- If you are in an RV or Camper they will collect the \$20 parking fee and give you a Windshield Sticker.
- ▶ A 5 mph maximum ground speed within the Swap Meet / Bike Show Grounds is enforced.
- ▶ No motorized vehicles whatsoever within the Swap Meet or Bike Show Grounds. No motorized or non-motorized bicycles allowed. There are just too many pedestrians.
- ► Three and four wheeled scooters are available for rent on the grounds for Handicapped individuals. Everyone else uses good walking shoes.
- ▶ 10 pm 7 am no vehicular movement whatsoever within the Swap Meet / Bike Show Event Area.
- No Motorcycles in the bike show may be removed from the show display until after 5 pm daily.
- ▶ RV Generators must not exceed the decibels shown during these times.
 - → 7 am 10 pm 70 decibels
 - ▶ 10 pm 7 am 45 decibels
- No stakes driven into asphalt or compacted material parking lots. Use weights to hold awnings down.
- ▶ Landing gear on RV's / Trailers will sit on 12" x 12" ¾" thick plywood.
- ▶ No Open Fires in Camping / RV Areas
- ▶ No firearms displayed.
- Pets will remain on a leash no longer than 6 feet at all times while on Texas Motor Speedway Property.
- ▶ No glass containers on any Texas Motor Speedway Property
- ▶ No selling of beverages or food on Texas Motor Speedway Property.
- No selling of any merchandise whatsoever with Texas Motor Speedway or NASCAR related symbols.
- Restrooms and Showers are on site.
- ▶ No club colors or patches will be allowed in this event. This is a family orientated event. Please leave your vest on your bike or vehicle in the parking lot.




